  - ISO 12402.5 level 50.
- Conditions 1, 2 and 3 do not apply if the lifejacket relies solely on oral inflation for buoyancy.
- Section 25(2) of the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016* does not apply in relation to the expiry date and service requirement for a lifejacket mentioned in section 25(1) if:
  - the lifejacket is one for which the manufacturer has established a documented servicing program; and
  - the owner and master of the ship adhere to the manufacturer's servicing program; and
  - the owner and master of the ship can produce documentary evidence of full adherence to the manufacturer's servicing program.

This notice repeals the Notification of Exemption which was published in the Queensland Government Gazette No. 19, volume 353, on 22 January 2010, and the Amended Notification of Exemption which was published in the Queensland Government Gazette No. 80, volume 353, on 26 March 2010.
