Requirement checklist

To ensure your application to register the temporary transfer is not unduly delayed, please ensure the following requirements are satisfied:

- Payment of temporary transfer fees
- Written approval of each person, other than the licence holder, who has an interest in the licence noted in the Register of Authorities
- Provision of a copy of the current company extract (see notes) for each company involved in the above transfer. You may provide a copy with your application, or a copy can be arranged on your behalf by contacting this office (fees apply).

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Notes:

The information in this checklist is to assist you in complying with the requirements of the *Fisheries Act 1994* that relate to the licence to be temporarily transferred. It should not be relied on for specific advice. It is not a precise statement of law and deals with matters that are subject to change. Witnesses to applicants signatures

The temporary transfer must be executed as follows:

- For individuals, signatures can be witnessed by any other person, the witness must be 18 years or over.
- For a corporation, the form is signed in accordance with the *Corporations Act 2001*, s127 by: either two directors, or a director and a company secretary, or the sole director who is the sole secretary.
- All applicants must be 18 years or over to hold an Authority.

Be aware that legislative provisions relating to the ability to take fish under the Authority becomes the transferee's right, while other responsibilities, for example, logbook compliance and invoice fee payments, remain with the original holder. For further clarification of the responsibilities between parties to the temporary transfer please contact the Department.

Company Extract

A company extract is a specific document issued by the Australian Securities and Investment Commission which identifies the directors and secretaries of the company. Please note that a certificate of incorporation **is not a company extract**.

Warning against increasing fishing effort

It is the responsibility of the transferee to ascertain whether the fishing authority being temporarily transferred may be used for the purposes intended and to seek advice on any **current investment warnings or management arrangements**, existing or proposed, that could affect the use of the fishing authority.
