NOTICE OF REPEAL OF '*TEMPORARY LOCAL PLANNING INSTRUMENT 03/16 REDEVELOPMENT OF BULIMBA BARRACKS*' PURSUANT TO SECTION 123 OF THE *SUSTAINABLE PLANNING ACT 2009*

At its meeting on 16 May 2017, Brisbane City Council adopted amendments to *Brisbane City Plan 2014* to include amendments to the Bulimba district neighbourhood plan together with necessary consequential amendments. The amendments apply to part of the suburb of Bulimba and will commence on **19 May 2017**.

Purpose and General Effect

The amendments are intended to facilitate the future redevelopment of the Bulimba Barracks to:

- Provide a mix of housing types and a new neighbourhood centre.
- Ensure development is sensitively integrated with surrounding residential areas.
- Provide for the retention and adaptive reuse of the historic fabrication workshop building for a range of retail, business, commercial and community uses.
- Provide for new streets that connect to the existing road network and provide sight lines through to the Brisbane river from key streets and public spaces.
- Provide sport and recreation land.
- Provide riverfront parkland including a land-based riverwalk with pedestrian and cycle connectivity.

At this meeting it was further resolved to repeal '*Temporary Local Planning Instrument 03/16 Redevelopment of Bulimba Barracks*' when the Bulimba district neighbourhood plan planning scheme amendments take effect on **19 May 2017**.

'Temporary Local Planning Instrument 03/16 Redevelopment of Bulimba Barracks' is not required when the amendments to the Bulimba district neighbourhood plan take effect.
