



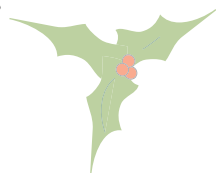

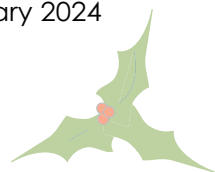

Notice is given under the *Planning Act 2016* that on 28 November 2023, Bundaberg Regional Council adopted the Bundaberg Regional Council Planning Scheme Policy for the Hughes and Seaview Bargara Local Plan Area and made an associated administrative amendment. The adopted planning scheme policy and associated amendment take effect on and from 4 December 2023.

The purpose and general effect of the Planning Scheme Policy is to provide an interim response to reflect further detailed land use and infrastructure planning completed for the Hughes and Seaview Bargara Local Plan Area until further amendments to the Bundaberg Regional Council Planning Scheme and Local Government Infrastructure Plan (LGIP) can be progressed by Council.

The Planning Scheme Policy is to be read in conjunction with the Central coastal urban growth area local plan code (included at Part 7 of the Planning Scheme), and provides additional guidance for the future development of land between Bargara Road, Hughes Road, Windermere Road and Seaview Road at Bargara.

The associated administrative amendment is made to Part 1, Table 1.2.5 (Planning scheme policies) and Schedule 6.1, Table SC6.1.1 (Planning scheme policy index) of the Planning Scheme, to reflect the adopted Planning Scheme Policy.

TEMPORARY LOCAL PLANNING INSTRUMENT NO. 1 OF 2023
(RESOURCE RECOVERY AND WASTE ACTIVITY REGULATION)**

Notice is given that Ipswich City Council has adopted Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 1 of 2023 (Resource Recovery and Waste Activity Regulation) (TLPI No. 1 of 2023), in accordance with section 23 of the *Planning Act 2016* and *Minister's Guidelines and Rules*.

The purpose and general effect of TLPI No. 1 of 2023 is to regulate resource recovery and waste activity uses within the Swanbank/New Chum and Ebenezer/Willowbank/Jeebropilly Regulation Areas to ensure these regionally significant economic areas are appropriately regulated to protect existing, approved or planned sensitive land uses from adverse impacts associated with waste activities.

The TLPI No. 1 of 2023 applies to land within the suburbs of Swanbank, New Chum, Willowbank, Ebenezer, Jeebropilly, Mount Forbes, Mutdapilly and Amberley, and suspends and otherwise affects the operation of the provisions contained in the *Ipswich Planning Scheme 2006* to the extent of matters outlined in the TLPI.

The TLPI No. 1 of 2023 will take effect on and from 11 December 2023. The TLPI No. 1 of 2023 will cease to have effect on 11 December 2025 or such longer period as may be permitted by law or unless repealed sooner.

Description of the designated premises

The MID applies to premises located at 28, 30 and 36 Browning Street, 12 and 25 Besant Street and 27, 27A and 35 Edmondstone Street, South Brisbane, QLD, 4101, formally described as Lots 1 and 2 on RP52694, Lots 208, 213 and 216 on B3137, Lot 1 on RP200323, Lot 1 on RP1440 and Lot 9 on RP1439.

Type of infrastructure for which the premises were designated

The infrastructure is described under Schedule 5, Part 2 of the *Planning Regulation 2017*, as:

- Item 3: community and cultural facilities, including community centres, galleries, libraries and meeting halls
- Item 6: educational facilities
- Item 9: facilities at which an education and care service under the Education and Care Services National Law (Queensland) is operated
- Item 12: hospitals and health care services.

Requirements included in the MID

The MID includes requirements in relation to the location and scale of the development, student enrolment capacity, stormwater management, car parking, bicycle parking, external works, school transport management, event management, acoustics, hours of operation, design/built form, local heritage place, landscaping, fencing, vegetation management, lighting, refuse plant and screening, construction management, information signage, public utility services, geotechnical conditions and acid sulfate soils.
