**TAKING OF EASEMENT NOTICE BY THE MINISTER
(No 03) 2016**

Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Taking of Easement Notice by the Minister (No 03) 2016*.

Easement taken [ss.6 and 9 of the Act]

2. The easement described in Schedule 2 is taken by Queensland Electricity Transmission Corporation Limited ACN 078 849 233 for electrical works purposes and purposes incidental thereto and vests in Queensland Electricity Transmission Corporation Limited on and from 22 July 2016.

Rights and obligations

3. That the rights and obligations conferred and imposed by the easement include the matters set out in Schedule 1.

**SCHEDULE 1
DEFINITIONS**

1. In this Easement:
 - 1.1 "Acts" means the *Electricity Act 1994* and *Government Owned Corporations Act 1993* and any amendments to them or either of them or any Acts superseding those Acts;
 - 1.2 "Associate" in relation to a party means that party's employees, secondees, agents, contractors, financiers, related bodies corporate and other invitees;
 - 1.3 "CMSHA" means the *Coal Mining Safety and Health Act 1999 (Qld)* and any other law relating to the prevention or minimisation of harm to persons caused by a workplace or workplace activities and includes any instrument, local law, regulation, rule, by-law, proclamation or orders made under any of them;
 - 1.4 "Date of this Easement" means the execution date of the Easement by the Registered Proprietor;
 - 1.5 "Easement" means the rights obtained from the Owner by QETC with respect to the Easement Land including but not limited to the terms and conditions contained in this Schedule;
 - 1.6 "Easement Land" means that portion of the Owner's land over which this Easement is obtained;
 - 1.7 "Owner" means the Registered Proprietor together with its successors, successors in title and assigns. Where the term appears in Clauses 3, 4, 5 and 6 it includes the servants, agents, employees, workmen and contractors of the Owner and other persons authorised by the Owner to use or enter upon the Easement Land; and
 - 1.8 "QETC" means the Queensland Electricity Transmission Corporation Limited, together with its successors and assigns and others authorised by it. Where the context permits, the term includes the servants, agents, employees, workmen, linesmen, contractors of QETC and other persons authorised by QETC to use or enter upon the Easement Land.
2. Subject to clause 6, QETC is acquiring this Easement in perpetuity to permit QETC the right to (at its own risk):
 - 2.1 pass and repass over the Easement Land at any time by day or by night;
 - 2.2 enter upon and traverse the Easement Land, with or without vehicles, plant and equipment, if necessary, to exercise its rights under this Easement;
 - 2.3 construct and maintain a track or road on the Easement Land to a standard that QETC determines;
 - 2.4 clear the Easement Land of trees, undergrowth or vegetation or any obstruction in the manner and by the means QETC considers appropriate (provided that it first complies with all laws associated with any clearing);
 - 2.5 enter upon and traverse the Easement Land for the

purposes of preventing or rectifying any infringement by the Owner of QETC's rights under this Easement; and QETC may in connection with its use and enjoyment of this Easement, exercise such of its rights, powers, discretion and functions under the Acts, or any other Act or at law as it sees fit.

QETC'S OBLIGATIONS TO THE OWNER

3. QETC will, in exercising its rights pursuant to this Easement:
 - 3.1 cause as little inconvenience to the Owner as possible; and
 - 3.2 act reasonably, including (except in emergencies) giving the Owner reasonable notice before accessing the Easement Land.

QETC WILL COMPLY WITH SAFETY LAWS

4. 4.1 QETC will comply with all laws, including the CMSHA (when applicable) regarding the use of this Easement and the safety of persons upon the Easement Land.
- 4.2 QETC will not be liable for:
 - 4.2.1 the negligent acts or omissions of the Owner; or
 - 4.2.2 the acts or omissions of the Owner that are a breach of this Easement or of the law; and the Owner indemnifies QETC (limited to an amount of 20 million dollars per claim or claims relating to the substantially the same set of facts) against any loss, damage or cost made against or incurred by QETC in connection with this Easement as a direct result of or directly arising out of the Owner's negligent acts or omissions, breach of this Easement or of the law.

THINGS THE OWNER MUST NOT DO

5. Subject to clause 6, the Owner must not unreasonably interfere with or obstruct QETC in the exercise or enjoyment of its rights and powers under this Easement.
6. Nothing in this Easement fetters the Owner or its Associates from any acts or omissions performed for the purposes of complying with the Owner's or its Associates' obligations under the CMSHA. For the avoidance of doubt, QETC will, and agrees to ensure that its Associates will, comply with any reasonable directions given by the Owner or its Associates in relation to compliance with the Owner's policies and procedures for the safe conduct of activities at its sites.

OWNER MAY USE EASEMENT

7. The Owner may use the Easement Land for any lawful purpose not inconsistent with the terms of this Easement.

INDEMNITY

8. QETC indemnifies the Owner against all actions, suits, proceedings, demands, costs, losses, damages and expenses arising out of or in respect of any act or omission of QETC in the use or attempted use of the Easement Land by QETC, except where such actions, suits, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, losses, damages or expenses arise as a result of any negligent act or omission of the Owner, breach of this Easement or of the law.

PUBLIC RISK

9. QETC will effect and keep current a public risk insurance policy in respect of this Easement and the use by QETC of the Easement Land for an amount which QETC considers appropriate to the public liability risk involved but in any event not less than TEN MILLION DOLLARS (\$10,000,000.00).

RELOCATION OF THE EASEMENT

10. 10.1 If the Owner intends to mine the Easement Land in away that is inconsistent with QETC's rights under this Easement, it will give QETC at least 2 years written notice that it requires the Easement to be relocated.
- 10.2 The Owner will use its best endeavours to provide QETC with an alternative easement location that is acceptable to QETC and the parties agree to do all things necessary to surrender this easement and grant a new easement in the alternative easement location.

QETC WILL PAY COSTS

11. In addition to the consideration payable under this Easement, QETC will pay:
 - 11.1 the costs of the preparation, execution and registration on the relevant property title of this Easement;
 - 11.2 the Owner's reasonable legal and (if applicable) valuation

costs;

- 11.3 the cost of obtaining any consent or approval to this Easement or survey plan from any mortgagee or other party having an interest in the land affected by this Easement or by any authority having jurisdiction in respect of the Easement Land or survey; and
- 11.4 the stamp duty and registration fees payable with respect to this Easement.

JOINT AND SEVERAL COVENANTS

12. Where there is more than one Owner, the covenants and agreements in this Easement are made by them severally to the extent of that Owner's interest in the land burdened by the Easement and is not joint or joint and several.
