Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 9 May 2023

Area: Southport pilotage area

Locality: Coomera River at Coomera Connector Worksite

Activity: Bridge construction

Mariners are advised that:

a temporary marine construction area will be established on the Coomera River from 19 May 2023, with two barges and additional support vessels facilitating construction activities for the Coomera Connector Stage 1 North project, in approximate position latitude 27°52.57'S, longitude 153°19.85'E. The marine construction area will remain in place for the duration of construction into 2025.

The Coomera River will remain open to navigation via temporary channel changes as required, with the navigation channel clearly marked with buoys at all times. Air draft of the bridge will remain unchanged at 6.4 metres.

Mariners should navigate with caution, maintain a safe distance off and operate at reduced speed with minimal wash in the vicinity of these works.

The supervisor of the work site will be monitoring VHF ch73 and can be raised for safe passing instructions to masters, should they be required.

Latitude and longitude positions are on WGS84 horizontal datum and are compatible with GDA94 datum.
