- Area: Southport pilotage area
- Locality: Russell Terrace, Macleay Island
- Activity: Foreshore protection works

Mariners are advised that:

Foreshore protection works will commence on 18 November 2024 at Russell Terrace, Macleay Island.

Works will be undertaken between 0700 hours and 1800 hours Monday to Saturday until late February 2025.

The outer boundaries of the work site will be marked with yellow buoys and lights FI Y 3s.

Silt curtains will have high visibility yellow floats and will be positioned within the work zone.

Work barge ZEUS and support vessels will monitor VHF radio channel 16.

The vessels will spud within the works area at night, maintaining navigational access.

Mariners should navigate with caution, maintain a safe distance off, and operate at minimum speed and wash in the vicinity of these works for the safety of the work site.

Latitude and longitude positions are on WGS84 horizontal datum and are compatible with GDA2020 datum.
