- (d) There is full and documented compliance with the provisions in the documents listed in paragraph (c) relating to Section R1.01 of rule book:
 - i. Training and assessment of junior competitors
 - ii. Separate and specific race briefings for junior competitors
 - The ships no longer than 3.6 meters with propulsion up to 20kw
 - iv. Each junior event is limited to 4 ships at any one time

 - viii. Wearing Crash helmets
 - ix. A lanyard is attached to the dead engine system.

- (e) The exemption applies only to persons operating ships within the age of 10 to 16 years operating ships with a maximum propulsion up to and including 27Hp or 20Kw, and:
 - i. Have participated in training and evaluated as competent by the Mackay Powerboat Club Incorporated
 - ii. To participants registered for the event described in the aquatic event issued September 2023 to the Mackay Powerboat Club Incorporated
 - iii. To ships operating on the course that meets the requirements of (d) in this exemption.
- (f) The Regional Harbour Master (Gladstone) is advised in writing of any change to the documents listed in paragraph (c) affecting the matters referred to in paragraphs (d) or (e) at least one month prior to holding an aquatic event with participation by unlicensed persons aged 10 to 16 years.
