QUANDAMOOKA LAND ASPIRATIONS AREA (TLPI 01/2023)  
REDLAND CITY COUNCIL LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA**

I, the Honourable Steven Miles MP, Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning, and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Games Infrastructure, notify that I have made TLPI 01/2023 in accordance with section 27(3) of the *Planning Act 2016* and the Minister's Guidelines and Rules. TLPI 01/2023 will have effect from 13 September 2023 until 13 September 2025, unless repealed sooner.

**Purpose and General Effect**

TLPI 01/2023 is a temporary local planning instrument under section 23 of the *Planning Act 2016*. Under section 23(3) of the *Planning Act 2016*, a temporary local planning instrument may suspend or otherwise affect the operation of another local planning instrument but does not amend or repeal the instrument.

The purpose of TLPI 01/2023 is to:

- provide land and residential housing opportunities for the Quandamooka people on Quandamooka Country, being land identified through a Native Title determination
- provide important future economic, social and cultural opportunities for the Quandamooka people
- contribute to State Planning Policy outcomes for housing diversity, cultural heritage and natural hazards, risk and resilience; and advance the purpose of the *Planning Act 2016* in promoting Aboriginal knowledge, culture and tradition, and also encouraging investment, economic resilience and economic diversity.

**Location of Area to which TLPI 01/2023 Applies**

TLPI 01/2023 applies only to part of the Redland City Council local government area, namely the land identified as within the TLPI 01/2023 area in **Attachment A** to the TLPI 01/2023.

Notice is given under the *Planning Act 2016* and the Minister's Guidelines and Rules Version 2.0 which commenced on 28 July 2023 that on 13 September 2023, Moreton Bay City Council adopted Temporary Local Planning Instrument No.01 of 2023 Morayfield South Emerging Community Area (TLPI 01/2023). TLPI 01/2023 will have an effective day of 16 September 2023 and will cease to have effect on 16 September 2025, unless repealed sooner.

**The purpose and general effect of TLPI 01/2023 is to:**

- provide an interim planning framework, including an Interim Structure Plan, to enable the Morayfield South Emerging Community Area to develop in an orderly and integrated manner that incorporates residential growth, infrastructure, services, parks, centres, housing diversity, schools and environmental corridors and links, to create a holistic and attractive future community;
- guide development in the Development Area Precinct within the Morayfield South Emerging Community Area to assist in meeting the region's housing needs and support economic growth;
- reduce potential character and amenity issues on the adjoining rural residential areas;
- ensure development provides development infrastructure in a safe, effective, efficient, timely, financially sustainable, equitable and coordinated manner for all infrastructure networks; and
- continue to preserve and not compromise the Future Urban Investigation Precinct by preventing development in this precinct until a plan for this precinct has been prepared and approved by the Moreton Bay City Council.

TLPI 01/2023 suspends and otherwise affects certain parts of the Moreton Bay Regional Council Planning Scheme 2016 relating to the Morayfield South Emerging Community Area and otherwise applies assessment benchmarks, in addition to the current assessment benchmarks of the current Moreton Bay Regional Council Planning Scheme 2016 being version 6, to all assessable development within the Morayfield South Emerging Community Area.
