Pursuant to a disciplinary hearing held on 19 July 2023 in relation to Mr Paul Edward Shirley electrical work licence, the Electrical Licensing Committee decided under section 121 of the *Electrical Safety Act 2002*:

- Grounds exist for taking disciplinary action
- Disciplinary action is to be taken against Mr Shirley.

Disciplinary action:

(1) In accordance with section 110 (1)(b) of the *Electrical Safety Act 2002*, the electrical work licence number NSW 284468C is suspended until Mr Shirley complies with the conditions set out below.

- UEEEL0030 Conduct compliance inspection of single phase LV electrical installations
- UEEEL0029 Conduct compliance inspection of LV electrical installations with demand exceeding 100 A per phase
- UEEEL0002 Apply currency of safe working practices and compliance verification of electrical installations
- (2) A penalty of 5 penalty units (\$500) is imposed under section 110(1)(d) of the *Electrical Safety Act 2002*.
- (3) A reprimand was issued in accordance with section 110(1)(c) of the of the *Electrical Safety Act 2002*.
