Memorandum to M^{rs} Licensed Surveyor

Attention is directed to the "Declaration on honor" on the back of Vouchers and in Letter accompanying plan, required of Surveyors of having personally effected surveys for which they have been instructed.

Several instances have come to the knowledge of the Department where the work has been done either by Assistants or by Pupils of Surveyors.

Such a practice is most reprehensible and quite opposed to the Rules and Regulations of the Survey Office, and the Surveyor General desires it to be clearly understood that in future any case of the kind brought under notice in which a Surveyor may be detected will be immediately followed by refusal of further employment with risk of cancellation of License.
