AMENDMENT OF BY-LAW No. 7

made under

"The Land Surveyors Acts, 1908 to 1916"

HIS Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to approve that By-law No. 7, as published in the *Government Gazette* of the 9th August, 1928, be amended by deleting the present clause 51 and substituting the following clause therefor:—

Maximum Allowable Misclosures

51. The misclosure in the linear measurements—
theodolite and chain surveys—should not exceed—

On town lands—

One inch in ten chains, equal to one link in a mile,
with a minimum allowance of one-tenth of a
link in any surround.

On country lands—

(a) On undulating country—One link in fifty chains.

(b) On rough and broken country—One link in
twenty-five chains.

(c) Where another surveyor's work is involved—
One link in twenty chains.

(d) Where surveys effected prior to 1890 are
included in the surround—One link in ten
chains.
