Regulation

The Theodolite is to be used in all surveys executed for this Branch of the Lands Department, except in the preliminary work of determining lines of roads, or internal features &c. or where the use of another instrument may be specially authorised.

In all cases the surveys must be conducted by means of angular observations on the limb of the instrument and recourse must not be had to the Magnetic Needle except for the purpose of taking the Magnetic bearings of a line.
