Memorandum

The attention of Surveyors is directed to the Regulation published in the "Gazette" of 21<sup>st</sup> Sept<sup>br</sup> 1889 page 164 by which the frontage allowed to Agricultural farms selected before survey is restricted to one-half of their depth.

The regulation is as follows;  
"Frontages to Main Roads or Main Watercourses.

"Lands selected before survey in any Agricultural Area, under the provisions of "The Crown Lands Act of 1884 Amendment Act 1885"; and having a frontage to a main watercourse or a main road shall not have a greater breadth of frontage thereto than one-half of the depth."
