Circular Memorandum re Astronomical Observations

Sir,

Reverting to the question of remuneration for Astronomical observations, it has been decided that the rate of payment for this work shall be as follows :—

For Azimuth,	
Solar observation, without calculation,	2s. 6d.
" with "	5s.
" 2 sets, calculated separately	7s. 6d.
" 3 or more "	
including Eastern and Western observations	10s.
Stellar obs.— 1 star, E. or W. along. with calculations	5s.
" 2 stars, E. & W. " "	7s. 6d.
" 3 or more " "	10s.
Series of observations on any group of surveys	21s.

It is to be understood that only a sufficient number of observations are to be taken to check the work in each locality, and in the event of a group of portions being surveyed at the same time the series of observations must extend throughout the group.

Calculations are to be forwarded with plans, and the observations are to be shown in a manner similar to that shown on attached circular.
