Memorandum to Mr. Staff Surveyor E. D. Mellor.

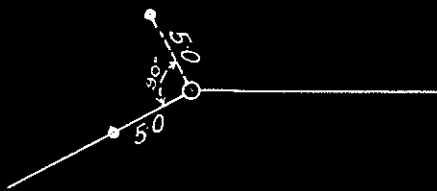
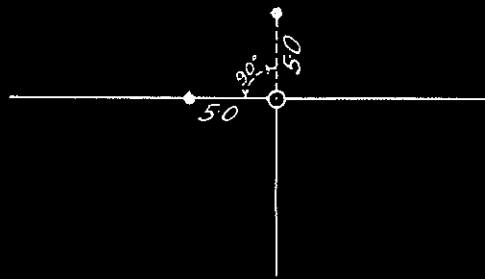
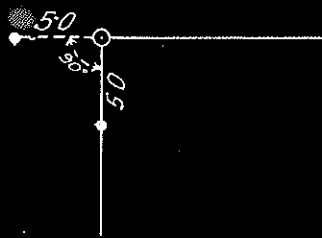
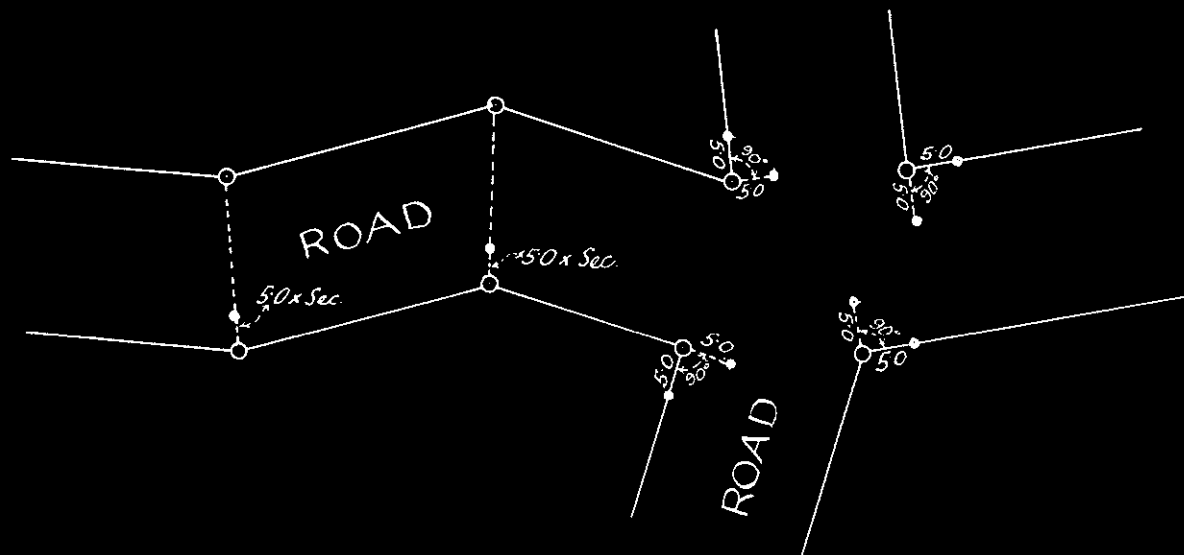

A blue print is enclosed showing suggestions for the placing of such pins at various corners but it is intended that in all cases you should use your own discretion and place the pin in the best positions available. Full particulars of the positions adopted should be shown in fieldnotes.
