Circular Memorandum

to

Re Stock routes or Driftways for stock

Stock routes are to be provided in such localities as may be found desirable, and with this view maps have been prepared and sent to the Local Commissioners' Offices shewing approximately the probable positions of such routes.

In general terms the Minister approves as follows -

Stock routes are to be one mile wide through Grazing areas, but where that cannot be done without too seriously damaging the value of any farm such Stock route may be contracted to half a mile. In Agricultural areas stock routes need not exceed 10 chains in width, in each case with 10 chains access to water & camping reserves at distances not exceeding 6 or 8 miles apart, such reserves not being necessary where town reserves already exist.
