Circular Memorandum to Authorised Surveyors.

Re Plan Drawing.

Attention is directed to Clauses 203, 212 and 214 of the "Rules and Directions for the Guidance of Surveyors" which set out requirements in respect to plan drawing. It is requested that these directions be observed.

Particular attention is drawn to Clause 212, as considerable inconvenience is caused by vital information being shown in blue on the face of plans only. As a consequence it does not appear on photographic copies.

It is desired therefore, that all information having reference to traverses, secants, connections across roads etc. be shown in black in the tablet provided on plan forms for this purpose.

It is also requested that original boundaries of roads closed or widened be shown on plans in fine broken brown lines. This information will then be reproduced on the photographic copies.
