I have no objection to a circular being issued meeting the case of surveyors who prefer one copy of the plan of survey boundaries & premises to the Dept. is a complete form upon such condition being

These plans appear complete & satisfactory. I see no objection to Mr. Hill employing a draftsman to complete the duplicate except that it is contrary to orders which require the surveyor to make in all cases lines and work except the writing & plotting. If relief is granted as asked for by Mr. Hill in respect of duplicate plans it should apply to all surveyors and a further circular be issued authorizing duplicate plans prepared in the manner suggested. I think however that by way of remedy to present somewhat indefinite expression "by personal supervision" the original order should also be ^{further} noted with the draftsmen whether in the surveyors camp or party otherwise, and the duplicate be immediately signed by the draftsman who makes it. In other respects the original order should remain in force both as to plotting and taking in the survey lines, and submitting the work to the Surveyor General for final completion.
