Circular Memorandum (No. 1).

MEMORANDUM TO

MR. AUTHORISED SURVEYOR.....

SURVEYS FOR MAIN ROADS COMMISSION.

You are advised that it has been approved that the following rates of payment for surveys carried out for the Main Roads Commission may be claimed as from 1st July, 1934:—

Corners, previously paid at 3s. 6d., will now be paid at 4s.

For slopes and side slopes of from 10° to 20°, add plus $\frac{1}{2}$ on base rate.

For lantana, where it is dense and continuous and exceeds a height of four feet, add plus three to base rate.

With exceptions as above stated, rates of payment in force to 30th June, 1934, will still apply.
