MEMORANDUM:


The attention of all authorised surveyors is brought to the following interpretation as handed down by the Queensland Surveyors' Board at its meeting of the 29th November, 1976.

(1) Clause 25 of By-law 7,

"Boundary lines which are re-measured or re-observed are not considered to be "resurveyed" unless remarking of these lines is specifically requested by the registered proprietor. Where such remarking is requested, it shall be carried out in accordance with Clause 25 except that lockspits will not be required".

(2) Clause 12 of By-law 7,

"The words 'degrees, minutes and seconds' in this Clause are intended to stipulate the system of units to be used in the recording of angles and bearings (sexagesimal) and not the standard of accuracy to which they are to be observed and recorded".
