Notice is given under the *Planning Act 2016* that on 18 October 2023 Logan City Council adopted *Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 1/2023* for the City of Logan.

The temporary local planning instrument (TLPI) will take effect on 30 October 2023 and cease to have effect on 30 October 2025, unless repealed sooner.

The purpose and general effect of the TLPI is to prevent potential loss of the city's flood resilience and suitably manage development in the floodplain in the local government area by:

- (a) suspending the operation of specific flood related provisions of the *Logan Planning Scheme 2015*, and
- (b) applying new flood related provisions affecting the operation of the *Logan Planning Scheme 2015*.

The TLPI overrides the provisions contained in the *Logan Planning Scheme 2015* to the extent of matters outlined in Part 3 of the TLPI. Where an inconsistency arises, the TLPI shall prevail.
