

Domestic and family violence practice standards

The Queensland Government is introducing new practice standards for the DFV sector effective from 1 January 2021. This single, consolidated set of standards will apply across all DFV service types.

The new standards are guided by the following principles:

- 1 The rights, safety and dignity of victims are paramount
- 2 Staff understand domestic and family violence
- 3 Services are evidence-informed
- 4 Perpetrators are held accountable for their actions
- 5 Services are culturally safe for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- 6 Services are client centred and accessible for all
- 7 Services collaborate to provide an integrated response
