Mariners are advised that:

Research equipment was established in Eurimbula Creek in August and November 2023. All buoys will remain in position until Thursday, 30 January 2025. Several buoys may be withdrawn prior to January with an updated Notice to Mariners to follow.

The equipment is attached to 90 cm metal stakes that are buried 50 cm in the ground leaving 40cm above the sea floor. They are installed in subtidal areas of the creek. The metal stakes will remain submerged at all stages of the tide and present a hazard to navigation.
