1. This notice may be cited as the *Amendment of Rural Water Pricing Direction Notice (No 02) 2011*.

Amendment of Notices (s.24AA of the Acts Interpretation Act 1954 and s.999 of the Water Act 2000)

2. (1) This notice amends the *Rural Water Pricing Direction Notice (No 01) 2006* (2006 Direction) made on 30 June 2006 and published in the Gazette on 14 July 2006 at page 1187 (authorising SunWater to set rural irrigation water prices for SunWater water supply schemes) as amended by the *Amendment of Rural Water Pricing Direction Notice (No 01) 2011* (2011 Amending Direction) made on 16 June 2011 and published in the Gazette on 1 July 2011 (extending SunWater's rural irrigation price path period to 30 June 2012).

Insert '2A. SunWater is also directed to comply with this notice in relation to rural irrigation water allocations held by the Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder in SunWater water supply schemes.'

(4) After paragraph 25 in the 2006 Direction as amended by the 2011 Amending Direction

Insert '**Pricing arrangement for the Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder**

26. Apart from the exception in paragraph 27, for all supplemented rural irrigation water allocations purchased and held by the Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder in the plan areas of the Queensland Murray Darling Basin Resource Operations Plans⁶ SunWater will charge a price equivalent to the rural irrigation water prices set in accordance with paragraphs 15 and 18 to 24 in the 2006 Direction as amended by the 2011 Amending Direction.

27. If the water supply scheme tariff group was not achieving lower bound cost recovery in 2010-11, the price for the Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder is the Lower Bound Cost Tariff (Tier 2) as determined in the *SunWater Irrigation Price Paths 2006/07 – 2010/11 Final Report*⁷, adjusted for CPI in accordance with

(a) paragraph 7 in the 2006 Direction for 2006/07 to 2010/11; and

(b) paragraph 15 in the 2006 Direction as amended by the 2011 Amending Direction for 2011/12⁸.

28. The pricing arrangement for the Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder as outlined in paragraph 26 and 27 applies from the day the notice is given to SunWater until 30 June 2012.'
