PROHIBITION OF SALE AND USE OF ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT **UNDER THE ELECTRICAL SAFETY ACT 2002**

I, BRIAN RICHARDSON, Director Equipment Safety and Licensing, Electrical Safety Office, Office of Industrial Relations, being the delegate of the regulator, acting under the Electrical Safety Act 2002, on reasonable belief that the below product does not comply with the safety criteria in AS/NZS 3820 (Essential safety requirements for electrical equipment), prohibit the sale and use by any person of:

- Lichtenberg fractal wood burning equipment which have electrodes operating at high voltage or low voltage and the electrodes can be contacted by a person while energised; or
- any equipment, purchased or homemade, that uses the principles of high voltage or low voltage electricity and electrodes to cause fractal burning patterns to be made in wooden or other surfaces, and the electrodes operate at high voltage or low voltage and can be contacted by a person while the electrodes are energised.

The prohibition of sale and use is effective from the date of publication of this notice in the Queensland Gazette. The prohibition remains in place unless rescinded by the Regulator.
