 - A proof of your notice and a quote for publication will be provided for you to check
- **Customer either accepts proof and makes payment online or returns proof for rework:**
 - If changes are required, email the change required and another proof will be forwarded
 - Once you have checked your proof and are happy to proceed to publication, please go to: <https://www.smartservice.qld.gov.au/services/bill/gazette> to make payment
- **Payment will be considered your authority to publish and the Gazette Team will be notified via email that your payment has been received:**

*Acquisition of Land Act 1967***TAKING OF EASEMENT NOTICE BY THE MINISTER
(No 02) 2015****Short title**

1. This notice may be cited as the *Taking of Easement Notice by the Minister (No 02) 2015*.

Easement taken [ss.6 and 9(7) of the Act]

2. The easement described in Schedule 2 is taken by Redland City Council for drainage purposes and vests in Redland City Council on and from 24 April 2015.

Rights and obligations

3. That the rights and obligations conferred and imposed by the easement include the matters set out in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1**Meaning of Terms**

1. The following words have the following meanings:
 - 1.1 “the Council” means the Redland City Council together with its successors;
 - 1.2 “the Land” means Lot 91 on RP133531 in the County of Stanley Parish of Russell contained in Certificate of Title Reference 14780196;
 - 1.3 “the Owner” means the registered owner of the Land from time to time; and
 - 1.4 “relevant works” means underground drainage pipes for the passage or conveyance of stormwater under the surface of the Easement together with all other usual or necessary fittings and attachments as well as works for the protection and/or support of all such things.

No obstruction to passage of rainwater

2. The Owner must not act, or omit from acting, in any manner that impedes the passage or conveyance of rainwater through or over the Easement.

Rights to Council

3. The Council shall have the full and free right and liberty at all times hereafter to enter upon the Easement for the purposes of removing any obstruction to the passage or conveyance of rainwater through, under or over the Easement and also to construct and thereafter forever to use and maintain such relevant works as it shall from time to time think fit and in so doing, the Council by its employees, agents and other persons authorised by the Council shall have the right to:
 - 3.1 inspect, maintain and repair, clear, clean and remove obstructions from the surface of the Easement;
 - 3.2 construct, install, extend, deepen, widen, cleanse, add to, remove, inspect, maintain and repair the relevant works and when and where thought fit by the Council to remove and replace the relevant works with new relevant works (whether of a similar nature to those replaced or not);
 - 3.3 dig into the Easement, and to open and break up the soil of the Easement or any part thereof including the sub-surface thereof;
 - 3.4 remove and dispose of spoil created as a consequence of the Council exercising its rights hereunder;
 - 3.5 clear the Easement including cutting and removing timber, trees and undergrowth from the Easement;
 - 3.6 enter upon and remain, pass and repass on and over the Easement for all or any of the purposes aforesaid, with or without vehicles, plant and equipment of any description whatsoever;
 - 3.7 do such other works and things through, across, in or under the Easement as are incidental to the proper exercise of the rights granted to the Council hereunder.

Property in Relevant Works

4. All relevant works are and remain the property of the Council notwithstanding any actual or apparent affixing to the Easement and the Council shall be solely responsible for the operation and maintenance of all relevant works,

Removal of Fencing

5. For the purpose of gaining access to the Easement the Council shall be entitled to pull down or break open any fencing on the Easement or on the Land, adjacent to the Easement.

Reinstatement of Fencing

6. The Council must reinstate all fences where the same have

been damaged by the Council in the exercise and performance of any of its rights and liberties granted herein PROVIDED the Council shall not be obliged to reinstate fences that have been constructed in breach of any covenants contained herein.

No Structures etc. on Easement

7. The Owner shall not at any time without the express written permission of the Council:
 - 7.1 erect any buildings or structures including fences upon the Easement or any part thereof or otherwise permit the Easement or any part thereof to be used in such a way as to obstruct or interfere with the passage or conveyance of rainwater through, under or over the Easement or interfere with the relevant works and/or the effective use thereof by the Council;
 - 7.2 install concrete, bitumen or other pavement or driveways on the Easement or gardens or landscaping involving concrete, brick or other permanent materials; or
 - 7.3 remove or stockpile or permit the removal or stockpiling of any soil, sand, gravel, or other substance or material on the Easement or construct any roads or other earthworks on the Easement which would in any way obstruct or interfere with the passage or conveyance of rainwater through, under or over the Easement or interfere with the relevant works and/or the proper and effective use thereof by the Council.

Inconvenience to Owner

- 8.1 The Council shall in its sole discretion determine how and in what manner the rights acquired by the Council hereunder are exercised,
- 8.2 the Council is not in any event responsible for any inconveniences or disturbance to the Owner or occupiers of the Land arising out of the course of or by virtue of the exercise by the Council of its rights hereunder.

Removal of Unauthorised Structures etc.

9. If a building structure or other material or thing is erected, placed, found or installed upon the Easement in contravention of Clause 7, the Council may, in addition to any other remedies and after having first given the Owner reasonable notice of its intention to invoke this clause, enter upon the Easement and remove or demolish the relevant matter and, if it does so:
 - 9.1 it may dispose of the relevant matter or any resultant demolition materials in such manner as it sees fit without being liable to account to the Owner (except as provided in clause 9.2); and
 - 9.2 it may recover, in any Court of competent jurisdiction, costs actually incurred by it in taking that action (including internal wage and salary costs) less any monies actually received by it as a result of disposing of the relevant matter or any resultant demolition materials.

Protection of Relevant Works

10. The Owner will not do any act or make any omission likely to jeopardise or prejudicially affect the safety or reliable working of any relevant works.

Removal of Trees

11. Council may enter upon the Easement and remove trees, shrubs or plants of any description that obstruct or interfere with the passage or conveyance of rainwater through, under or over the Easement or interfere with the relevant works and/or the proper and effective use thereof by the Council.

Risk and Indemnity

- 12.1 The exercise of the Council’s powers, rights and liberties herein and the use of the Easement shall be at the risk of the Council except to the extent of the Owner’s or occupiers or their respective invitees, employee’s, agent’s or contractor’s negligent or wilful acts or omissions,
- 12.2 The Council releases and indemnifies the Owner against any claim against the Owner arising from or associated with this Easement or the Council’s use of the Easement, except to the extent caused by the negligence or wilful act or the omission of the Owner or occupier or their respective invitees, employees, agents or contractors.
