Other matters considered by the QPB include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • progress reports for life sentenced prisoners • interstate parole orders that have been transferred to Queensland, and • applications for international travel, regardless of sentence length. <p>The CSA (s231) prescribes the functions of the Regional Parole Boards. The Regional Parole Boards consider matters for offenders that are sentenced to a period of imprisonment less than eight years. Other matters considered by the Regional Parole Boards include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • applications for interstate travel for a period more than seven days, and • court ordered parole matters excluding interstate and international travel.
