

Name of the proposal	<p>The Criminal Code and Other Legislation (Double Jeopardy and Subsequent Appeals) Amendment Bill 2023 enhances criminal justice system responses to possible wrongful convictions and subsequent appeals by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• establishing a statutory framework to allow a person convicted on indictment or of a summary offence under section 651 of the Criminal Code to make, with the leave of the Court of Appeal, a subsequent appeal against the conviction; and• expanding the double jeopardy fresh and compelling evidence exception to 10 prescribed offences in addition to murder.
