Proposal type	Details
Minor and machinery in nature	<p>This proposal is minor and has zero/negligible regulatory costs.</p> <p>The proposal is to implement the Mornington Shire Council's request to increase the alcohol carriage limit for Mornington Shire and surrounding foreshore from 4.5L (the equivalent of 12 x 375ml cans) of permissible alcohol, being any combination of beer or pre-mixed spirits with an alcohol concentration of up to and including 4% alcohol by volume (ABV) to 11.25L (the equivalent of 30 x 375ml cans) of permissible alcohol, being any combination of beer or pre-mixed spirits with an alcohol concentration of up to and including 4% ABV.</p> <p>The proposed amendments reduce restrictions on alcohol carriage limits on Mornington Island and seek to reduce consumption of illicit homebrew. The proposed changes are consistent with the Mornington Island Community Safety Plan and the Queensland Government's Renewed Approach to Alcohol Management. The 11.25 litre limit is not expected to lead to an increased risk of harm for Mornington Island residents. Moreover, this amendment is consistent with data and community feedback gathered since the zero-alcohol limit was relaxed. For context, the carriage limit for Mornington Island was increased from zero to 4.5L of permissible alcohol in April 2022.</p> <p>The proposal is minor in nature and is not likely to add to the regulatory burden as it is not introducing a new regulatory requirement but amending the limit beyond which alcohol is prohibited in the restricted area.</p>
