



Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required	<p>The proposed amendments would allow the disclosure of limited information to accredited media entities to enable them to identify where and when particular Childrens Court criminal proceedings will be conducted. Safeguards would apply to protect children's privacy and prospects of rehabilitation.</p> <p>The proposal relates to police powers and administration, general criminal laws, the administration of courts and tribunals and corrective services. No regulatory impact analysis is required under the <i>Better Regulation Policy</i>.</p>
