(1) any obstruction, interruption, impeding, hampering or interference, diversion, scouring, change or alteration in or to the flow or escape of stormwater drainage or its or their natural outlet (if any) or

(2) any ponding of waters or

(3) any interference or obstruction to the Support

caused by or consequent upon

(a) any use to which the said land may be put or

(b) the erection, raising, making, placing or suffering to stand or to remain of any building, fence, wall, structure (whether of the class just mentioned or not) paving or vegetation (except grass, vegetation or landscaping which is to be properly maintained at all times) or thing whatsoever upon the Said Land or

(c) any alteration in level or gradient of the Said Land or any change to the surface of the Said Land or to the natural or artificial features of the Said Land which contain or assist in containing the flow of stormwater drainage over the Said Land

other than as is or are permitted in writing by the Council or the Permanent Head for the time being of Brisbane Infrastructure Division of the Council and only on such terms and conditions as the Council or the Permanent Head may impose or stipulate in the event of such permission being granted with power for the Council and its

contractors, agents and servants (but without prejudice to any other powers or remedies for the Council) at the cost to the owner or owners, registered proprietor or registered proprietors or occupier or occupiers from time to time and for the time being of the Said Land or any of them

- (i) to demolish, remove or otherwise dispose of any building, fence, wall, structure (whether of the class just mentioned or not) paving or vegetation (except grass which is to be kept properly mown) or thing whatsoever at any time on or in the Said Land in contravention of the foregoing provisions and
- (ii) to perform any works necessary for restoring or reinstating the Said Land (including the grass thereon) and the natural or artificial features containing or assisting in the Support and/or in containing or assisting in the flow of stormwater drainage over the Said Land to their former state and condition and also
- (iii) to alter, grade, pave, prepare, grass, fertilize, prune, remove vegetation or mow the surface of the Said Land or place, install, establish or construct and keep any earthworks and any other works whatsoever (whether of the class just mentioned or not) thereon or therein for the purpose of the exercise of the rights hereinbefore given or incidental thereto or for the purpose of forming the surface of the Said Land in such a way as to contain the flow of stormwater drainage or for the purpose of rectifying or alleviating any scouring of the said land due to the flow of stormwater drainage thereover.

 - 1.2 Alternative Easement Land means that part of Lot 8 on SP218634, County of Clinton, Parish of Calliope that is nominated by the Owner to be the new Easement Land under clause 7.3.1.
 - 1.3 “Date of this Easement” means the execution date of the Easement by the Owner.
 - 1.4 Dominant Tenement means Lot 1 on SP218634, County of Clinton, Parish of Calliope.
 - 1.5 “Easement” means the rights granted by the Owner to QETC with respect to the Easement Land including but not limited to the terms and conditions contained in this Schedule.
 - 1.6 “Easement Land” means Easement C on SP218634,

County of Clinton, Parish of Calliope.
1.7 “Owner” means Rio Tinto Aluminium Limited, together with its successors, successors in title and assigns. Where the term appears in Clauses 3, 4, 5 and 7 it includes the servants, agents, employees, workmen and contractors of the Owner and other persons authorised by the Owner to use or enter upon the Easement Land.

1.8 “QETC” means the Queensland Electricity Transmission Corporation Limited (trading as Powerlink Queensland), together with its successors and assigns and others authorised by it. Where the context permits, the term includes the servants, agents, employees, workmen, linesmen, contractors of QETC and other persons authorised by QETC to use or enter upon the Easement Land.

1.9 Yarwun Switchyard means Lot 1 on SP218634, County of Clinton, Parish of Calliope.

QETC’S RIGHTS

2. The Owner grants this Easement in perpetuity to permit QETC the right to:

2.1 pass and repossess over the Easement Land at any time by day or by night;

2.2 enter upon and traverse the Easement Land, with or without vehicles, plant and equipment, if necessary, to exercise its rights under this Easement;

2.3 enter upon and traverse the Easement Land for the purposes of preventing or rectifying any infringement by the Owner of QETC’s rights under this Easement; and

in granting these rights the Owner acknowledges that QETC may in connection with its use and enjoyment of this Easement, exercise such of its rights, powers, discretion and functions under the Acts, or any other Act or at law as it sees fit.

QETC’S OBLIGATIONS TO THE OWNER

3. QETC must:

3.1 in exercising its rights pursuant to this Easement:

3.1.1 cause as little inconvenience to the Owner as possible;

3.1.2 act reasonably;

3.1.3 comply with the Owner’s safety and security policies of which the Owner gives notice to QETC, from time to time; and

3.1.4 comply with the Owner’s reasonable directions given under clause 7.4;

3.2 execute and return to the Owner any document which the Owner provides to QETC, for execution, in accordance with clause 7.3.3; and

3.3 for the avoidance of doubt, ensure that QETC’s employees, agents, contractors and other persons authorised by QETC to use or enter upon the Easement Land comply with the terms and conditions of this Easement.

QETC WILL COMPLY WITH SAFETY LAWS

4. 4.1 QETC will comply with all laws regarding the use of this Easement and the safety of persons upon the Easement Land.

4.2 QETC will not be liable for:

4.2.1 the negligent acts or omissions of the Owner; or

4.2.2 the acts or omissions of the Owner that are a breach of this Easement or of the law

and the Owner indemnifies QETC against any loss damage or cost made against or incurred by QETC to the extent caused or contributed to by the Owner’s negligent acts or omissions, breach of this Easement or of the law.

THINGS THE OWNER MUST NOT DO

5. The Owner must not interfere with or obstruct QETC in the exercise or enjoyment of its rights and powers under this Easement.

OWNER’S ENTITLEMENTS

6. It is the parties’ intention that QETC must at all times be entitled to access the Yarwun Switchyard either via the Easement Land or an equivalent alternative means of access pursuant to clause 7.

7. The Owner may do any of the following:

7.1 use the Easement Land for any lawful purpose not

inconsistent with the terms of this Easement and the rights granted to QETC;

7.2 temporarily prevent QETC from accessing the Easement Land but only if the Owner complies with the following conditions:

7.2.1 the Owner must notify QETC of the closure of the Easement Land as expeditiously as possible before the closure occurs, unless it is not reasonably possible to do so, in which case, the Owner must notify QETC of the closure as expeditiously as possible after that closure occurs; and

7.2.2 the Owner must provide QETC with an equivalent alternative means of access to the Yarwun Switchyard at all times during the temporary closure of the Easement Land pursuant to clause 7.2.1.

7.3 permanently relocate the Easement land but only if the Owner complies with the following conditions:

7.3.1 the Owner gives QETC not less than 1 calendar month’s written notice of its intention to relocate the Easement Land, which notice must be accompanied by a plan which clearly identifies the new easement land;

7.3.2 the Alternative Easement Land is reasonably suitable to enable QETC to exercise its rights under this Easement, and in particular, to gain access to the Yarwun Switchyard; and

7.3.3 the Owner must, at its expense, prepare all documents necessary to evidence the surrender of the Easement Land, the easement document covering the Alternative Easement Land on the same terms contained within this easement document (excluding clause 11) and register the surrender and easement documents in the Department of Environment and Resource Management, at the Owner’s cost. For the avoidance of doubt, the Owner may exercise its rights under clause 7.3 as many times as it wishes during the currency of this Easement but at all times QETC must have suitable access to the Yarwun Switchyard.

7.4 Supervise QETC’s activities and conduct when exercising a right of access under this Easement, provided that the Owner must act reasonably when doing so.

OWNER’S OBLIGATIONS

8. The Owner must, during the currency of this Easement:

8.1 construct (if a road or track has not already been constructed) and maintain a track or road on the Easement Land to a standard which will reasonably enable QETC to exercise its rights under this Easement; and

8.2 keep the Easement Land clear of trees, undergrowth or vegetation or any other obstruction which would prevent QETC from exercising its rights under this Easement.

INDEMNITY

9. QETC indemnifies the Owner against all actions, suits, proceedings, demands, costs, losses, damages and expenses arising out of or in respect of any act or omission of QETC in the use or attempted use of the Easement Land by QETC, except to the extent such actions, suits, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, losses, damages or expenses arise as a result of any negligent act or omission of the Owner, or a breach of this Easement by the Owner.

PUBLIC RISK

10. QETC will effect and keep current a public risk insurance policy in respect of this Easement and the use by QETC of the Easement Land for an amount which QETC considers appropriate to the public liability risk involved but in any event not less than ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS (\$100,000,000.00).

QETC WILL PAY COSTS

11. In addition to the consideration payable under this Easement, QETC will pay:

11.1 the costs of the preparation, execution and registration

- 11.2 on the relevant property title of this Easement; the Owner's reasonable legal and (if applicable) valuation costs;
- 11.3 the cost of obtaining any consent or approval to this Easement or survey plan from any mortgagee or other party having an interest in the land affected by this Easement or by any authority having jurisdiction in respect of the Easement Land or survey; and
- 11.4 the stamp duty and registration fees payable with respect to this Easement.

JOINT AND SEVERAL COVENANTS

12. Where there is more than one Owner, the covenants and agreements in this Easement are made by them jointly and severally.

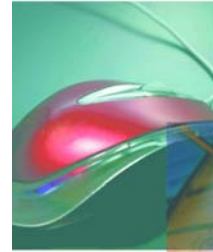

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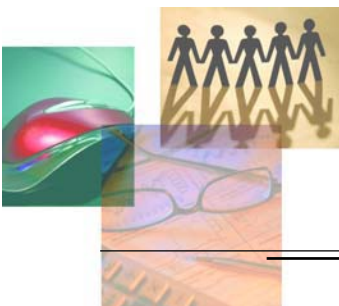
