Minor and machinery in nature	<p>The Gas Supply Amendment Regulation 2024 includes only minor consequential amendments to extend the application of relevant provisions relating to the connection and disconnection of 'processed natural gas' to 'covered gas' in order to give effect to the amendments to the <i>Gas Supply Act 2003</i>.</p> <p>As such, this proposal is minor and has no regulatory costs as the Gas Supply Amendment Regulation 2024 makes minor consequential amendments arising from the <i>Gas Supply and Other Legislation (Hydrogen Industry Development) Amendment Act 2023</i>.</p> <p>The proposal ensures the Gas Supply Regulation 2007 is consistent with the <i>Gas Supply Act 2003</i> and does not result in a substantive change to regulatory policy or new impacts on business, government or the community.</p>
