

There's an **Indigenous** business for that!

In FY23/24, the Queensland Government procured over \$535.9M in goods and services from Indigenous businesses. That's \$93.9M more than the previous year.

That increase makes a difference.

\$93M could supply groceries for 8,720 families of four for a year. It could rent 4,402 houses in outback Queensland for a year, or it could fund the cost of school education for 1,368 kids starting school in regional and remote Queensland.

But we're not done yet.

We all have a role to play in meeting our 3% procurement spend with Indigenous businesses so next time you make any purchase, consider how the spend can make a difference.
