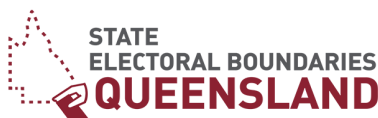

Section 10(e)**MINISTER'S DIRECTION NOTICE**

Pursuant to section 10(e) of the *Queensland Competition Authority Act 1997* (QCA Act), I direct the Queensland Competition Authority (QCA) to investigate and provide a report (the Report) on the South East Queensland (SEQ) Bulk Water Price Path (the Price Path), in order to inform Government in preparation for the next regulatory pricing period, due to commence on 1 July 2018.

In the Report, the QCA should provide advice on an optimal regulatory approach for SEQ bulk water pricing, given the specified policy objectives and considerations detailed below.

Policy Objectives

Since 1 July 2008, SEQ bulk water prices have been determined with reference to the Price Path. The Price Path was developed with a view to limiting price increases for bulk water out to the end of the Pricing Period (1 July 2008 to 30 June 2028).

SEQ bulk water prices have been determined until 30 June 2018, which is 10 years after the commencement of the Price Path. In preparing for the next review of SEQ bulk water prices, it is appropriate to consider the implications of the approach and policy settings that currently influence SEQ bulk water prices.

This will assist Government in assessing the most appropriate way forward to determine SEQ bulk water prices, taking account of the impacts on SEQ water consumers, the Queensland Bulk Water Supply Authority (Seqwater), and the State of Queensland.

In preparing for the next review of SEQ bulk water prices, Government is seeking to achieve the following objectives:

- Identify the appropriate price signals necessary to drive the efficient use of water in an economic, social and environmental sense, taking into account any conflicts between these factors (e.g. whether there are trade-offs between pure economic efficiency and customer impacts/environmental objectives, such as water conservation);
- Ensure that efficient costs of the Seqwater in meeting the Government's specified Level of Service are fully recovered;
- Consideration of Seqwater's financial sustainability over the long-term (up to and beyond 30 June 2028); and
- Mitigate customer impacts arising from potential changes to the current regulatory approach (to the extent that issues with the current approach are identified).

In reporting on these matters, the QCA should note the following policy considerations:

- 'Price Path Debt' (the accumulated losses arising from the Bulk Water Price Path) is to be recovered through prices by 2027-28;
- The opening Regulatory Asset Base used by the QCA for the 2015-18 bulk water review is to be adopted.

Considerations

In the Report, the QCA is directed to examine and provide advice on optimal pricing arrangements for SEQ bulk water supply giving consideration to the following:

- tariff structure and implementation of alternative tariff structures;
- the conditions or circumstances that would justify a move away from the common price (postage stamp) approach to a form of nodal pricing;
- the appropriate rate of return;
- key cost considerations;
- length of regulatory period;
- managing revenue uncertainty and changes in costs during the regulatory period; and
- Any other matters raised by the QCA in the chapter titled "Future Reviews" in the Final Report, SEQ Bulk Water Price Path 2015-18 that the QCA considers pertinent to the provision of this advice.

Consultation with Seqwater

Where necessary, the QCA should engage with Seqwater in the preparation of the Report. The QCA must balance the need to adequately inform itself of matters raised in this direction, whilst minimising Seqwater's resource requirements in responding to any request for information.

Timing

The QCA should provide the Report by Friday 28 October 2016.
