- The Council will at all times hereafter in the case of an open earth drain keep such drain and all appurtenances thereof tidy and in good order and condition and clear of grass, weeds or rubbish of any kind.

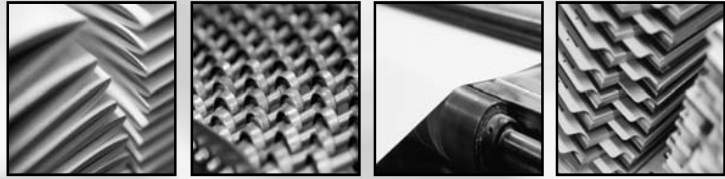

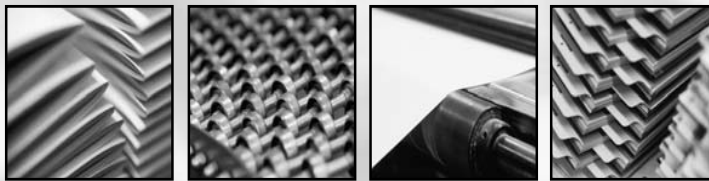
