Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 14 June 2023

**Area:** Brisbane pilotage area  
**Locality:** Brisbane River – Centenary Bridge  
**Activity:** Geotechnical investigation works

Mariners are advised that:

Geotechnical investigation works will commence in the vicinity of the Centenary Bridge on Tuesday, 13 June 2023 between 0700 hours and 1700 hours for approximately 3 weeks. These operations will be conducted from a self-propelled spudded barge 12 meters in length.

The barge will be anchored in the approximate position latitude 27°31.661'S and longitude 152°56.801'E. The barge operator will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 13 and display an all-round white light in conjunction with quick flashing yellow lights on the corners between sunset and sunrise and during conditions of restricted visibility

Mariners are requested to navigate with caution when transiting the area.

Latitude and longitude positions are on WGS84 horizontal datum and are compatible with GDA2020 datum.
