Short Title

1. This order in council may be cited as the *Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 1) 2021*.

Administrative Arrangements

2. (1) The public business of the State is distributed among Ministers as set out in the Schedule.
- (2) Each Minister is to administer the matters set out in the Schedule next to the Minister's title as follows:
- the matters connected with the public business of the State listed under the heading '*Principal Ministerial Responsibilities*';
 - the legislation listed under the heading '*Acts Administered*'; and
 - the administrative units listed under the heading '*Administrative Units*'.
- (3) Information in the Schedule under the heading '*Responsible Heads*' is included for information only and does not form part of this order.

Repeal of earlier Administrative Arrangements

3. The *Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 2) 2020* is repealed.

Commencement

4. This order commences on 1 July 2021.
