SUMMARY OF ENFORCEMENT NOTICE**

To: Michael John Webber

Mount Isa City Council ("**Council**"), the local government for the premises at 14 Dempsey Street, Mount Isa, described as Lot 48 on plan MPH21969 ("**the premises**"), reasonably believes a structure on the premises, being the boundary fence fronting Dempsey Street and Patricia Street is dangerous, in a dilapidated condition and unfit for use.

Take notice that Council gives an enforcement notice to you as the owner of the premises pursuant to section 248(4) of the *Building Act 1975* as it considers the matter about which it gives the enforcement notice is dangerous in nature.

You are required to comply with the notice in the following way:

- (a) By **5:00pm on Friday, 18 December 2020:**
- (i) undertake work, to repair or rectify the structure, so as to ensure the structure is no longer dangerous nor in a dilapidated condition; and
 - (ii) provide to Council a report from an appropriately qualified person that the structure is no longer dangerous nor in a dilapidated condition.
- (b) Council records indicate the existing fence forms part of a pool barrier, therefore any erected fencing and/or building works must maintain a compliant pool fence/barrier at all times.
- (c) Within seven (7) business days of completion of the works required under item (a) above, provide Council with a copy of a current pool safety certificate.

NOTE: You are advised to contact a building certifier licenced to practice in Queensland to determine whether a building development application is required for the work required by the notice.

Pursuant to section 168(5) of the *Planning Act 2016*, it is an offence to contravene the notice. Pursuant to section 250 of the *Building Act 1975*, you may appeal to a development tribunal against the giving of the notice. Any appeal must be started within 5 business days after the day the notice is given to you.
