**Notice of Adoption of Temporary Local Planning Instrument 01/16 Protection of Buildings Constructed Prior to 1911 (TLPI 01/16)**

At its meeting on 8 February 2016, Brisbane City Council adopted TLPI 01/16 which will commence with immediate effect and cease to have effect at the end of 7 February 2017 (unless repealed at an earlier date).

**Purpose and General Effect**

The purpose of TLPI 01/16 is to facilitate protection of residential buildings constructed prior to 1911 at 18, 20 and 26 Jones Street, Highgate Hill, and 54 and 58 Quay Street, Brisbane City. The TLPI provides for the assessment of any removal or demolition of any pre-1911 building on the subject sites.

TLPI 01/16 applies to the following properties:

- 18 Jones Street, Highgate Hill, described as Lot 58 on RP11740
- 20 Jones Street, Highgate Hill, described as Lot 59 on RP11740
- 26 Jones Street, Highgate Hill, described as Lots 60-62 on RP11740
- 54 Quay Street, Brisbane City, described as Lot 9 on RP8697
- 58 Quay Street, Brisbane City, described as Lot 17 on RP8698

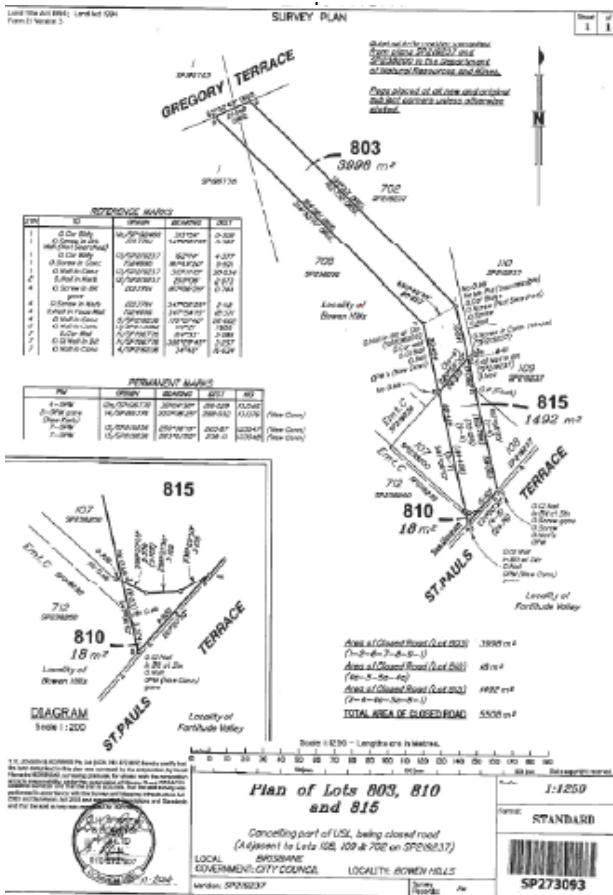
