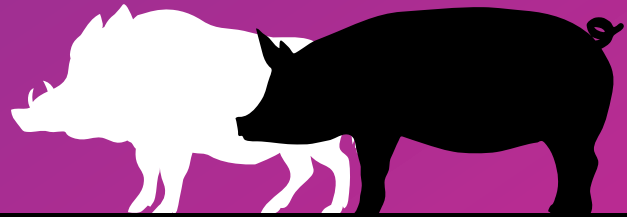


# BE AFRICAN SWINE FEVER AWARE!



## WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN PIGS

Sudden death, blotchy/reddened skin, high fever, weakness, panting/coughing, diarrhoea



## DO NOT FEED PIGS MEAT

Protect your pigs from emergency animal diseases – do not feed them food or food scraps that contain or have been in contact with meat or meat products



## PROTECT YOUR RUBBISH FROM PIGS

Always dispose of farm waste and food scraps properly so pigs can't get to it



## BE PREPARED

Have a biosecurity plan in place to protect your pigs from emergency animal diseases



## REPORT

Early detection is critical – report any concerns to **Biosecurity Queensland on 13 25 23**
