PROHIBITION OF SALE AND USE OF ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT **UNDER THE ELECTRICAL SAFETY ACT 2002**

I, BRIAN RICHARDSON, Director Equipment Safety & Licensing, Department of Justice and Attorney-General, being the delegate of the regulator, acting under the Electrical Safety Act 2002, on reasonable belief that the below type does not comply with the safety criteria in AS/NZS 3820 (Essential safety requirements for electrical equipment), prohibit the sale by any person of:

a flexible heating pad (also known as electric hot water bottle or electric heat pack) incorporating a bladder containing a conductive liquid and low voltage live electrodes that are used for heating the internal liquid.

The prohibition of sale is effective from the date of publication of this notice in the Queensland Gazette.
