*Planning Act 2016*

### DIRECTION TO CHIEF EXECUTIVE OF THE *PLANNING ACT 2016* – CURRENT APPLICATIONS

I, the Honourable Jarrod Bleijie MP, Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations, direct, pursuant to section 95 of the *Planning Act 2016* (the *Planning Act*), the Chief Executive of the *Planning Act* (Chief Executive) to not decide the applications (the applications) stated in the Schedule for a period of 4 months (the Stated Period) after the date this direction was gazetted.

I note that I may call in the applications or give a further direction within the Stated Period. I may not call in any of the applications after the Stated Period ends.

The state interests for which this direction is given are –

- (a) an interest that affects an economic or environmental interest of the State or part of the State; and
- (b) the interest of ensuring the *Planning Act* purpose is achieved.

The reasons for the direction are –

- (a) Each of the developments the subject of the applications, involve or are likely to involve, the State interests set out above in particular, State interests articulated in the relevant regional plans and the State Planning Policy 2017 (SPP).
- (b) The SPP underscores planning's role in economic growth, supporting both traditional and emerging sectors by:
  - a. emphasising the importance of providing a safe, reliable, and affordable supply of energy for a sustainable Queensland.
  - b. highlighting the importance of safeguarding biodiversity through informed planning and development decisions.
  - c. ensuring that planning supports community needs and promotes innovative responses to challenges.
- (c) The proposed developments fall within the North West Regional Plan 2010, Central Queensland Regional Plan 2013 and Darling Downs Regional Plan 2013. Each support growth of energy infrastructure where environmental and social values are protected.
- (d) The proposed developments are each for significant wind farms with a large number of turbines and ancillary infrastructure, and substantial clearing. More specifically:
  - a. The applications are for respectively 170, 175 and 204 turbine wind farm developments together with various types of ancillary infrastructure.
  - b. Extensive clearing of native vegetation is proposed for all projects. The Wongalee wind farm proposes to clear 2172 ha, Theodore wind farm proposes to clear 1932 ha and Bungaban wind farm proposes to clear 6.7 ha.
  - c. Each wind farm requires haulage of construction materials and wind farm infrastructure across Queensland's transport network.
- (e) Each of the developments are complex and significant projects in relation to their respective potential social, economic and environmental impacts.
- (f) Each development application is subject to code assessment under the *Planning Act* and do not require public notification.
- (g) Planning has a role in economic growth, supporting both traditional and emerging sectors through emphasising the importance of a sustainable energy supply, safeguarding biodiversity and supporting community needs, as reflected in the SPP and the relevant regional plans.

- (h) Accordingly, I consider each application requires proper assessment under the Planning Act, including but not limited to, relevant infrastructure, environmental and community considerations.
- (i) This direction suspends the assessment of these applications, to allow the consideration of the assessment framework that applies to each application having regard to the purpose of the Planning Act to provide an efficient, effective, transparent, integrated, coordinated, and accountable planning system.
- (j) Each of the three development applications are currently under assessment by the assessment manager and have not yet been decided, and therefore the exercise of the Planning Minister's discretion at this time to suspend the assessment is appropriate.
- (k) Before deciding to issue this direction, I was provided with briefing material by the Department of State Development, Infrastructure and Planning.

An existing engineered stone benchtop, panel or slab is an engineered stone benchtop, panel or slab installed before 1 July 2024.

#### **The work or circumstance this exemption applies to is:**

This exemption applies to work involving the reinstallation and any associated minor modification and repair required of an existing engineered stone benchtop, panel or slab. This is to enable temporary removal so that other works, such as repairing underlying cabinetry or plumbing, may be undertaken, with the engineered stone benchtop, panel or slab then returning to its original position.

Works on the engineered stone benchtop, panel or slab within the scope of this exemption include:

- minor modification to enable reinstallation; and
- repairs, due to any damage caused during the removal or minor modification process.

#### **Regulations to which the exemption applies:**

This exemption applies to section 529D of the *Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011* – Work involving engineered stone benchtops, panels or slabs—prohibition.

#### **Conditions of the exemption:**

In accordance with section 691(1) of the *Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011*, the regulator imposes the following conditions in relation to this exemption:

- Processing of the existing engineered stone benchtop, panel or slab while uninstalled must be:
  - limited to:
    - minor modification to enable reinstallation; or
    - repair, due to any damage caused during the removal or minor modification of the engineered stone; and
  - no more significant than processing that would be permitted for an installed engineered stone benchtop, panel, or slab under section 529F(a)(iii) of the *Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011*.
- If processing is required, it must be controlled in accordance with section 529B of the *Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011*.
- If processing is required, the relevant PCBU must notify the regulator of the work being undertaken consistent the requirements under chapter 8A, part 8A.4 of the *Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011*.
