Classification of invasive species

Land Protection (Pest and Stock Route Management) Act 2002

The former Land Protection (Pest and Stock Route Management) Act 2002 classified invasive species as class 1, 2, or 3. This system was used until 2016.



Biosecurity Act 2014

The [Biosecurity Act 2014](#) classifies species as either prohibited or restricted. Several prohibited species have been found in Queensland and are included in the survey.

Invasive plants



Invasive animals



Category 2: A person must report the invasive species within 24 hours to 13 25 23.

Restricted invasive plants (Cat 2, 3, 4, 5): must be reported (as above), cannot be moved, kept, released into the environment, given away or sold.

Restricted invasive plants (Cat 3): cannot be released into the environment, given away or sold.

Restricted invasive animals (Cat 2, 3, 4, 5, 6): must be reported (as above), cannot be released into the environment, given away or sold; cannot be moved; must not be kept; and must not be fed.

Restricted invasive animals (Cat 3, 4, 5, 6): cannot be released into the environment, given away or sold; cannot be moved; must not be kept; and must not be fed.

Restricted invasive animals (Cat 3, 4, 6): cannot be released into the environment, given away or sold; cannot be moved; and must not be fed.
