The alignment amendment has the purpose and general effect of:

- replacing terminology or language from repealed or soon-to-be-repealed legislation with terminology consistent with the Act, including but not limited to names of categories of development or categories of assessment and content for the regulated requirements in the *Planning Regulation 2017*
- improving and clarifying assessment benchmarks, notably codes, to ensure they are sufficiently robust to permit assessment as required by the decision rules for code assessment under the Act. The codes which have been amended are Rural Zone Code, Industrial Zone Code, Commercial Zone Code, Tourism Code and the General Development Code.
