The 2016 Preliminary Queensland Road Toll

The preliminary Queensland Road Toll for 2016 was 251 fatalities. This is eight fatalities (or 3.3%) greater than the previous year of 243 fatalities and six fatalities (or 2.4%) fewer than the previous five year average.

The preliminary Queensland road fatality rate for 2016 was 5.18 fatalities per 100,000 population, which is 1.9% greater than the 2015 rate of 5.09.
