




District profile

Overview

The Far North District covers an area of about 273,158km², or around 15.8% of Queensland.

It extends from the Torres Strait Islands in the north to the top of the Cardwell Range in the south, and from Cairns in the east to Croydon in the west.

The district has an estimated residential population of about 272,615 or around 5.9% of Queensland's total population.¹

The district looks after about 2,942km of other state-controlled road and about 217km of the National Network.

District program highlights

In 2013-14 we completed:

- repairs to flood damaged roads across the district as part of the Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA), jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- construction of the Cairns Bruce Highway Upgrade project between Sheehy Road and Ray Jones Drive, funded by the Australian Government
- realignment of the Cardwell Range on the Bruce Highway, 15km north of Ingham, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government

- widening of Wrights Creek bridge and approaches on the Bruce Highway, south of Cairns, funded by the Australian Government
- construction of a roundabout on the Captain Cook Highway at the intersection with Port Douglas Road
- construction of overtaking lanes on the Bruce Highway, north of Cardwell near Dundonald Creek, funded by the Australian Government
- widening of a boat ramp at Yorkey's Knob
- installation of green paint treatments at priority intersections to delineate cycle lanes on the Captain Cook Highway and Mulgrave Road.

In 2014-15 we will:

- commence transport infrastructure works associated with the Cape York Region Package (an agreed program of works and associated Queensland Government funding is currently under negotiation with the Australian Government)
- commence the six-laning extension of the Bruce Highway between Robert Road and Foster Road as part of the Cairns Southern Access Corridor Stage 2 project, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government

- commence sealing 12.5km of the Endeavour Valley Road, Cooktown
- complete widening and sealing a section of the Gillies Range Road, Goldsborough
- complete sealing of a 9km section of the Peninsula Developmental Road between Rocky Creek and Koolburra
- complete construction of a new bridge at Nettle Creek on the Kennedy Highway, funded by the Australian Government
- complete widening and pavement rehabilitation works at the Millstream section of the Kennedy Highway, funded by the Australian Government
- complete a floating walkway at Yorkey's Knob
- complete two-laning of the Kennedy Developmental Road between Three Ways and The Lynd
- complete construction of overtaking lanes on the Bruce Highway between Tully and Cardwell at Yellow Waterholes, and north of Tully between Broderick Road and Feluga Road, funded by the Australian Government.

Future plans

We are continuing to plan for the future transport requirements of residents in the Far North District.

In 2014-15 we plan to:

- commence planning for the future duplication of the Bruce Highway between Gordonvale and Edmonton
- develop a strategy to seal Peninsula Developmental Road from Laura to Weipa
- complete planning and preliminary design activities for the Smithfield Bypass
- conduct a Household Travel Survey and Visitor Travel Survey to enable the Cairns Transport Model to be updated to produce more robust results.
