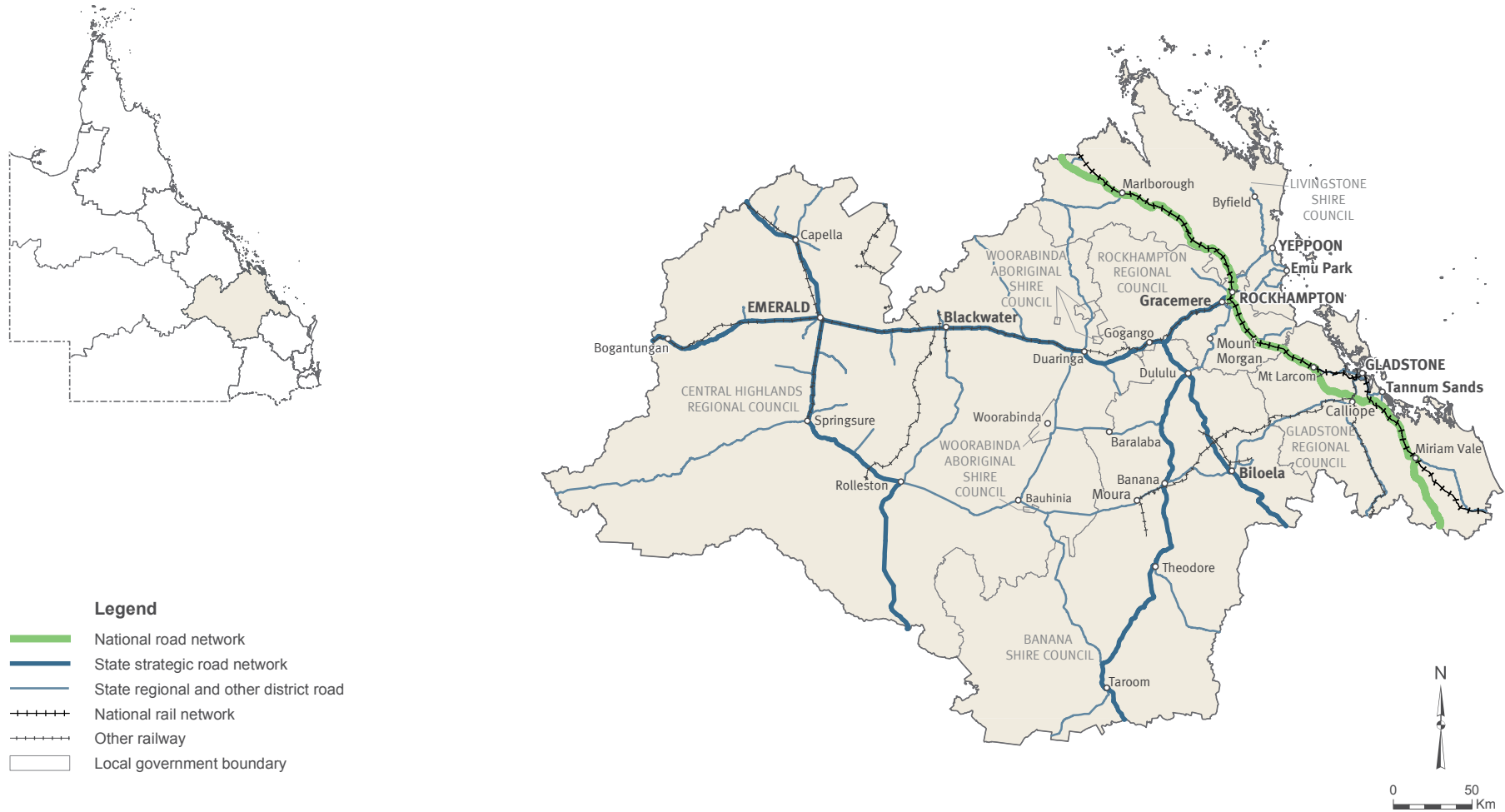

District profile

Overview

The Fitzroy District covers an area of about 117,813km², or around 6.8% of Queensland. It extends from north of Capella to south of Taroom, and from Gladstone in the east to west of Emerald.

The district has an estimated residential population of about 229,483 or around 4.9% of Queensland's total population.¹

The district looks after about 3,164km of other state-controlled roads and about 366km of the National Network.

District program highlights

In 2013-14 we completed:

- construction of the Yeppen North project, at the southern entrance to Rockhampton, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- construction of the Calliope Crossroads Interchange upgrade at the intersection of the Bruce Highway and Dawson Highway, west of Gladstone, funded by the Australian Government
- safety upgrades at the Bruce Highway intersections with Gentle Annie Road/Sinclair Street (Ambrose), Tynan Street (Marmor), Meldrum Road (North Rockhampton), Etna Creek Road/Vass Road (Etna Creek), funded by the Australian Government.

In 2014-15 we will:

- commence intersection improvements at Phillip Street, Kin Kora Roundabout, Gladstone, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government as part of the Queensland Government's Royalties for the Regions Program
- continue to provide a new elevated crossing of the Bruce Highway across the Yeppen Floodplain, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government
- provide funding to Banana Shire Council for paving and sealing of Eidsvold-Theodore Road, Theodore, as part of the Queensland Government's Royalties for the Regions Program
- provide funding to Central Highlands Regional Council for upgrading sections of the Arcadia Valley Road, south of Rolleston, as part of the Queensland Government's Royalties for the Regions Program
- complete realignment of the Dawson Highway and Leichhardt Highway intersection in Banana as part of the Liquefied Natural Gas Proponent Funded Program.

Future plans

We are continuing to plan for the future transport requirements of residents in the Fitzroy district.

In 2014-15 we plan to:

- finalise a link assessment for rest areas and stopping places within the Fitzroy District.
