**NOTICE OF MINISTERIAL INFRASTRUCTURE DESIGNATION  
MADE UNDER THE *PLANNING ACT 2016***

I, the Honourable Steven Miles MP, Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Infrastructure, give notice that under section 38 of the *Planning Act 2016*, I made the Ministerial Infrastructure Designation (MID) for the Mount Cotton Fire and Rescue Station on 26 May 2023.

The MID will take effect from 30 May 2023.

**Description of the designated premises**

The MID applies to premises located at 1974-1984 Mount Cotton Road, Carbrook, formally described as Lot 2 on SP327919.

**Type of infrastructure for which the premises were designated**

The infrastructure is described under Schedule 5, Part 2 of the *Planning Regulation 2017*, as:

- Item 8: emergency services facilities

**Requirements included in the MID**

The MID includes requirements in relation to the location and scale of the development, car parking, bushfire management stormwater management, external works, emergency vehicle priority signals design/built form, landscaping, earthworks, vegetation, public utility services, lighting, refuse and plant screening, construction management, information signage, geotechnical conditions and acid sulfate soils.
