Minor and machinery in nature	<p>The Proclamation commences provisions of the <i>Casino Control and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2022</i> (CCOLAA) amending the <i>Wagering Act 1998</i> and <i>Wagering Regulation 1999</i> to provide the State's exclusive sports wagering licensee with the ability to conduct wagering on approved simulated sport and racing events and contingencies; and establish a framework for Government consideration and approval of virtual events for wagering purposes, and for the evaluation and approval of equipment generating those events.</p> <p>This proposal is machinery in nature and gives effect to legislative amendments already made by Parliament.</p>
